The US Dept. of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) defines literal homelessness as a person or family who live in a place not meant for human habitation (including the streets or in their car), emergency shelter, transitional housing, and hotels paid for by a government or charitable organization.

**Duplication: Clients and Households will be counted each month their record is open, so it would be inappropriate to add the YTD and MTD together (Clients and Households are unduplicated for YTD totals)

***"HMIS Record" is client level data for any individual served within the reporting period

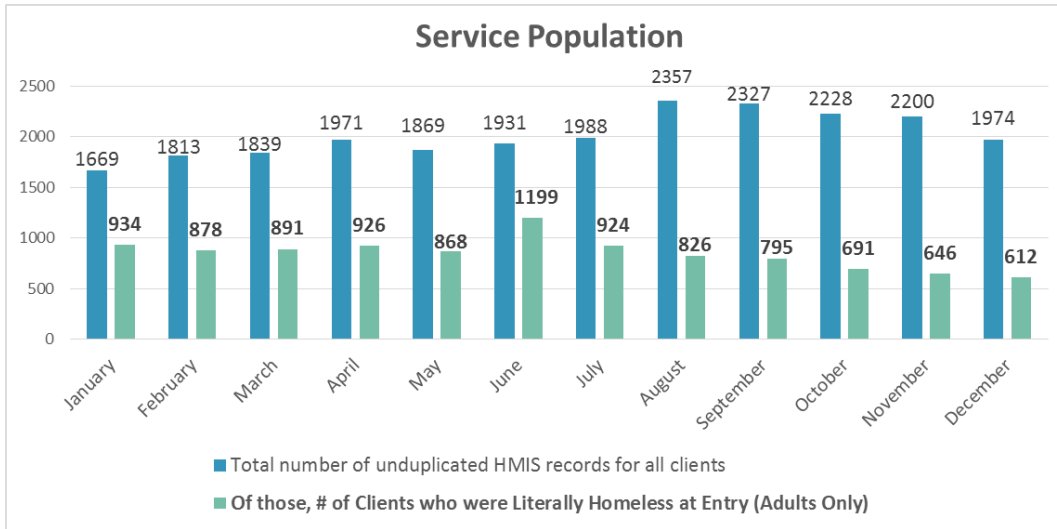
NEW Prevention clients: this measure looks at prevention clients who are NEW to the system only.

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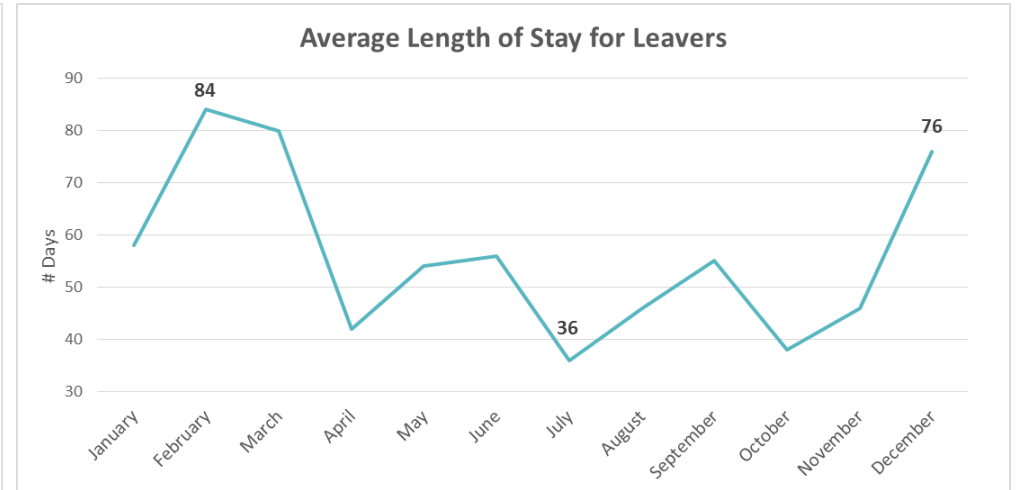
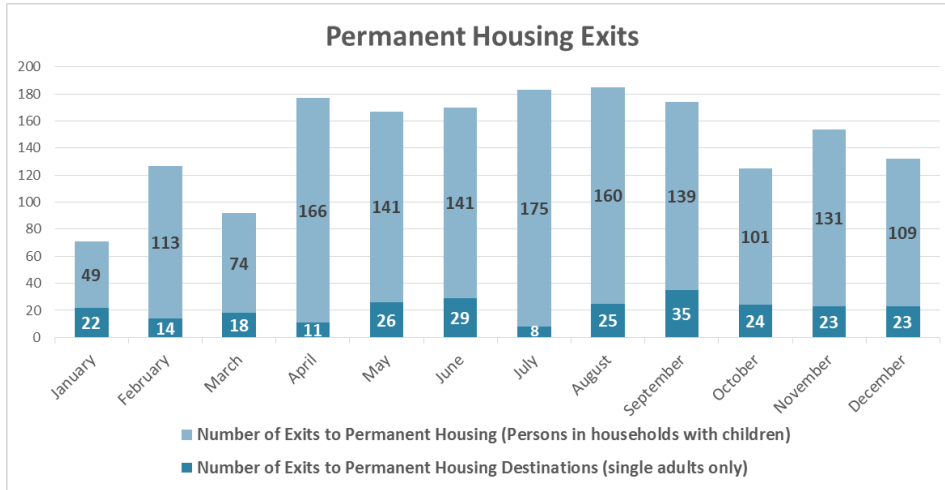
